



## VOTING IN THE 2021 ELECTIONS ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021

### VOTER REGISTRATION

Voters must register by **Monday, October 18**.

Voters may still register to vote on Election Day, **November 2**, with proof of identity and proof of residence.

### ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL

In order to vote by mail, you must request an absentee ballot from the county auditor's office by **Monday, October 18**.

County auditors will begin mailing absentee ballots on **Wednesday, October 13**.

All ballots must be returned to the county auditor's office by **8:00 p.m.** on Election Day, **November 2**.

The only people who can return a voter's absentee ballot are the voter, someone living in the voter's household, or an immediate family member.

If the voter is blind or has another disability, a delivery agent is assigned.

### IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING

Voters can vote absentee in-person at the auditor's office beginning **Wednesday, October 13**.

The last day to vote absentee in-person is **Monday, November 1**.

### VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

Election Day polling places will close at **8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 2**.
